# LETTER FROM INCOMING PRESIDENT



**Dear** TAM members and friends:

I have only been in office for a few months, but have appreciated your interest in and support of TAM. This past year has presented new opportunities and challenges, and TAM remains a strong presence in Idaho Falls and the surrounding communities. I have some thoughts about the past and the future of our art museum.

First, Alexa and her staff continue to provide consistent, effective leadership and service to our members and to the public that visit the museum. In 2025 we experienced some shifts in staffing. Amy Thompson is our new Development Director, and has hit the ground running. She comes to us from a solid marketing and branding background and has been very active in increasing membership and in engaging with the public. Maya Peters-Greño joined us in July and as our Visitor Services Coordinator and Registrar. She is doing great work and is broadening our appeal to the general public. Carina Rocco is the new Education Curator overseeing

education programming and is increasing our educational outreach. Of course our Director of Operations, Jessica Hull Livesay, continues to expertly and guide our financial operations and records.

Second, I have to recognize all the Board Members who give their time and attention to TAM's well-being. The organization would not work without their help. Some special thanks to the financial committee (John Beal, Jonathan Peterson, Jenni Garren, and Lexie French) in helping to navigate economic shifts and steer us toward calmer financial waters.

Third, the Education Center project forges ahead toward the goal of a new Education Wing for the Museum. Generous donors have so far pledged or contributed about \$700,000 to the fund, but we still have a long way to go. We have cleared all governmental and building/zoning issues. We are now about to submit an RFP/RFQ to formally engage architects to put plans in place. We anticipate that when construction begins, we will do so in several independent phases as funds are obtained. Thus, careful planning is essential to make the funds go as far as possible. And, of course we need your continued financial support in this endeavor, as well as your continuing support as a Member at TAM.

Fourth, I would be remiss if I failed to mention the loss of governmental funding for the arts and humanities. The near future is uncertain. We are not alone in this situation and we

will be competing with other arts organizations for limited funds. Our private fundraising continues at pace and we have done well with recent events. The Society for Animal Artists upcoming exhibition will bring us some national exposure and revenue.

I cannot overemphasize the importance of Membership to our bottom line. If you can, I urge you to join as a member and to increase your level of membership if you are already on board. Amy and the staff are continuing to provide more benefits incident to membership, and being a Member is well worth the effort.

Finally, I submit that TAM continues to fulfill its central role of bringing art to the public and educating the public in matters connected with the visual arts. We are and will continue to further our mission. I invite you to help us along the way.

# 2024-2025 EDUCATION PROGRAMING

## ARTWORKS

During the 2024-2025 school year, TAM continued to serve as a vital visual arts resource for families, community organizations, and students in regional schools through TAM’s education programs.

Three free Community Days enlisted museum educators and volunteers to serve more than 2,000 visitors who participated in hands-on artmaking experiences. In addition, TAM provided over 600 visitors and students with guided museum tours that included interactive art lessons, and hosted seven monthly art visits to preschool students at Head Start.

In April, the annual *Young at ART* exhibit and the *Congressional Art Competition* featured the artwork of more than 900 Idaho students, grades K-12. TAM also partnered with the Idaho Falls Public Library to provide free family passes as part of the youth summer reading program.

In July, TAM participated in Chalk Fest, highlighting the work of youth alongside professional chalk artists and offering free, hands-on family art activities. TAM also presented ARTWorks for Educators, an annual professional development opportunity that gives area teachers hands-on learning in the arts to better support creative learning in their classrooms.

In total, the ARTworks program impacted more than 5,000 students, family members, and educators throughout southeastern Idaho.



## YOUTH & TEEN CLASSES

During 2024–25, students ages 4–18 participated in a wide range of youth classes and camps. TAM offered three ARTrek summer camps for children ages 5–12, and for the second year provided summer art camps specifically designed for teens.

Responding to high demand, two additional adult Clay Studio sessions were added to the schedule. With three new Clay Studio instructors bringing fresh ideas, the program has grown in both creativity and community. In May 2025, thanks to support from the Gabby Fund, TAM proudly installed a new kiln to fire ceramics onsite for the first time.

## CLASSES & WORKSHOPS FOR ADULTS

During 2024–25, TAM offered Beginning Watercolor, Beginning Drawing, ongoing Clay Studio sessions, and a variety of workshops led by Linda Aman, Diane Hill, and Sally Cannon Ellis exploring color theory, perspective drawing, and painting.

The TAM Education Department also continued partnerships with The Development Workshop, Inc. (DWI) and the Alzheimer’s Association, providing accessible art classes for disabled adults and for adults with early-onset or full dementia and Alzheimer’s disease.

TAM also continued to host hour-long lectures by regional scholars on a wide range of topics, free to all TAM members.



# TEENS @ TAM

The inaugural year of the Teens @ TAM program was a great success, and the program continues to thrive as a cornerstone of The Art Museum of Eastern Idaho’s youth engagement efforts. Designed to empower high school students through art, leadership, and community service, the program provides participants with meaningful opportunities to shape museum initiatives while developing their own skills and confidence.

This past school year, the teen group brought fresh energy and ideas to the museum. Members designed and executed teen-friendly events, assisted with family programs, designed and installed a collaborative, community art project; hung our *Young at ART* exhibit, and acted as peer ambassadors, helping to make the museum a more welcoming place for visitors of all ages. Leadership roles within the group gave older students the chance to guide projects, mentor peers, and learn firsthand how cultural institutions operate.

In addition to service and leadership, the program emphasized creative expression. Teens collaborated on special projects, gained behind-the-scenes insight into exhibitions, and contributed to shaping programming that reflects their generation’s voice. Many reported that their time at TAM helped them build friendships, confidence, and a stronger sense of connection to both The Art Museum and their community.

By investing in the next generation, Teens @ TAM strengthens not only the museum’s present vitality but also its future. These young leaders are leaving their mark—both within the galleries and beyond—through their curiosity, creativity, and commitment to the arts.
