Create a CLAY TILE

SUPPLY BOX

Paper & Pencil
Plastic Knife
Clay
Rolling Pin
Toothpick
Sponge
Paint
Cup of Water
Brush
String

PLAN A DESIGN

Using paper and pencil, create a design for your tile. Draw a scene from nature, your family pet, or design a pattern using repeating geometric shapes.



ROLL OUT THE CLAY

Shape the clay into a ball by rolling it in your hands. Next, use a rolling pin to roll the clay into a thin slab, about 1/2-inch thick. Use the knife to cut the clay into a shape such as an oval, square or rectangle. Poke a small hole in the top of the tile so that you can display it later.

ADD THE DETAILS

Use small pieces of clay to form the shapes of your design. Rub the back of each piece with a damp sponge so the pieces will stick to your tile. Use a toothpick to draw smaller details such as eyes, hair, or whiskers in the tile. When you have finished, set the tile aside and let it dry overnight.

PAINT AND DISPLAY

The next day, use paint to add color to your design. When finished, tie a small piece of string or ribbon through the hole at the top of your tile. Hang your tile and show off your amazing artwork!
